The Ken Aston Cup is an annual referee "competition" within an AYSO tournament that promotes refereeing excellence through feedback from experienced referee evaluators. Teams of referees are evaluated on their performance during tournament matches.

In 2025, The Cup will be presented in conjunction with Region 68's California Strawberry Cup Tournament



- Participation is open to currently registered AYSO volunteers
- Each referee participating in the Ken Aston Cup will receive a token of recognition.
- The highest scoring referee team in each Division will receive an additional token of achievement and recognition in the Whistle Stop newsletter.
- There will be a Saturday event for all Cup participants to socialize and a Sunday awards ceremony.
- Any AYSO Section may nominate referee teams and / or evaluators to participate.
- A limited number of hotel accommodations (double occupancy) will be made available for Evaluators traveling from long distances



- Each match will have a minimum of 3 Evaluators assigned.* Evaluators are expected to work as a team in both in observing the referee team and in a debriefing session lasting no more than 30 minutes. Feedback will be actionable and constructive.
